*When staying at a “Shukubo”, guests are required to observe the rules and regulations of each temple.*

### Fukuoizan Shougakuji Temple 福王山 正覚寺 (Soto Sect 曹洞宗)

Charge: ¥6,500 with breakfast & dinner

Access: ①From Ikebukuro Sta., take the Seibu Ikebukuro Line to Hanno Sta. 飯能駅 (1 hr. by Express 急行)

②From Hanno Sta., take a Kokusaikogyo Bus bound for Yunosawa 湯ノ沢 or Nago 名郷  
Nago Bus Stop. (55 min.)

③1 min. walk from the bus stop

- Notes:
- Reservations must be made at least 3 days in advance.
  - You may enter the temple between 3:00 pm and 4:30 pm.
  - You must participate in “Zazen” (Zen meditation).
  - You are expected to understand a little Japanese or accompanied by a Japanese speaker.

### Daiyuzan Saijoji Temple Shikaryo 大雄山 最乗寺 知客寮 (Soto Sect 曹洞宗)

Charge: ¥5,000 with breakfast & dinner

Access: ①From Odawara Sta. 小田原駅, take the Daiyuzan Line to Daiyuzan Sta. 大雄山駅 (21 min.)

②From Daiyuzan Sta., take a Izu Hakone Bus to Doryoson Bus Stop 道了尊 (10 min.)

③10 min. walk from the bus stop

- Notes:
- Reservations must be made about 1 month in advance.
  - You may enter the temple between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm.
  - Reservations are usually accepted for groups of 10 people or more.  
Booking for less than 10 people are accepted only on the 27<sup>th</sup> every month.
  - Be sure to be accompanied by a Japanese person or by a Japanese speaker.
  - Morning chant service is available. (Participation is optional.)



## Minobusan Kuonji Temple Kakurinbo 身延山 久遠寺 覚林坊 (Nichiren Sect 日蓮宗)

Charge: ¥5,000 with breakfast, ¥8,000 or ¥10,000 with breakfast & dinner

Access: ①From Shinjuku Sta., take the JR Chuo Line to Kofu Sta. 甲府駅 (1 hr. 40 min. by Limited Express 特急)

②From Kofu Sta., take the JR Minobu Line to Minobu Sta. 身延駅 (1 hr. by Limited Express 特急)

③Take a taxi or a Yamanashi Kotsu Bus to Minobusan Bus Stop 身延山 (15 min.)

④10 min. walk from the bus stop

Notes: •Reservations must be made at least 3 days in advance. (You must tell your arrival time.)

•Nichiren Sect does not give “Zazen” service.

## Minobusan Shoboin Temple Takenobo 身延山 正法院 竹之坊 (Nichiren Sect 日蓮宗)

Charge: ¥5,000 without meals, ¥6,300 with breakfast, ¥8,400 with breakfast & dinner

Access: ①From Shinjuku Sta., take the JR Chuo Line to Kofu Sta. 甲府駅 (1 hr. 40 min. by Limited Express 特急)

②From Kofu Sta., take the JR Minobu Line to Minobu Sta. 身延駅 (1 hr. by Limited Express 特急)

③Take a taxi or a Yamanashi Kotsu Bus to Minobusan Bus Stop 身延山 (15 min.)

④5 min. walk from the bus stop

Notes: •Be sure to be accompanied by a Japanese person or by a Japanese speaker.

•Reservations must be made 1 week in advance. (check-in 2:00 pm / checkout 10:00 am)

•Nichiren Sect does not give “Zazen” service.

## Komadori Sanso 駒鳥山荘 (Lodge for Shinto pilgrims)

Charge: ¥5,400 without meals, ¥8,400 & up with breakfast & dinner

Access: ①From Tokyo Sta., take the JR Chuo Line to Ome Sta. 青梅駅 (1 hr. 15 min. by “Ome-Tokkai” special rapid service)

②From Ome Sta., take the JR Ome Line to Mitake Sta. 御嶽駅 (20 min.)

③From Mitake Sta., take a Nishi Tokyo Bus to Cable-shita Bus Stop ケーブル下バス停留所 (10 min.)

④Walk 150m to Cable Car Takimoto Sta. 滝本駅, and take a cable car to Mitakesan Sta. 御岳山駅 (6 min.)

⑤15 min. walk from Mitakesan Cable Car Sta.

**(You must leave Tokyo by 3:00 pm to be sure to catch the last cable car at 6:30 pm.)**

Notes: •Reservations can be made even on the day you wish to stay, if there is a vacant room. (check-in 3:00 pm / checkout 10:00 am)

•English is spoken.

•“Zazen” service is not given at Shinto facilities.
